- This Summer June 21-24 we will be going to Big Stuf in Panama City Beach, FL.
- Big Stuf is on the beach and rents out Boardwalk Beach resort all summer for camp.
- On the page below there is a schedule of what each day will look like.
- Students are required to let their leader know where they will be during free time.
- Our Student to leader ratio is 5:1
- Electronics will be taken up when they get on the bus at church.
- Parents must sign up for the text message system to receive updates.
- Your child will have access to leaders phones if they need to reach you.
- There is a mandatory parent meeting on June 9th after second service in the MSM room.
- Paperwork is due on June 9th. Final balance is due June 10th.

Students must sign and follow our behavioral guidelines below.

“1. I will not leave the group for any reason. 2. I will participate in all group activities that I am physically able. 3. I understand the need for separated sleeping arrangements and will honor this. 4. No sexual activity; or any sexual material or paraphernalia. 5. I understand that I am not allowed to POSSESS or USE any type of weapons, tobacco, alcohol, or any other type of drugs, as well as fireworks. 6. I will respect the authority of the adult leaders and follow their instructions.”

- There will be a bag check at check in.
- Dress code is as follows: Girl One piece or fully covered tankini. Please double check your daughters swim suits bottoms. We will ask them to put on shorts if it is revealing.
- Sleeping arrangements will be pre-assigned based on small group, age and who their leader is. As always, it will be two students per bed, or one to a bunk. Grace Chapel will all be rooming together.
