 - "Hitting the mark"
- Are you enjoying God?
 - Is your relationship with God delightfully satisfying?
 - Does it "hit the mark" of inner joy beyond anything else in your life?
- What do the Scriptures say?
 - Psalm 37:4

Delight yourself in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart.

- Hebrew Anag, meaning to <u>take exquisite delight</u>
- Psalm 43:4
 - ...God my exceeding **joy**...
 - Hebrew Simchah, meaning gladness, glee, pleasure

Habakkuk 3:17-18

Though the fig tree should not blossom, nor fruit be on the vines, the produce of the olive fail and the fields yield no food, the flock be cut off from the fold and there be no herd in the stalls, **yet I will rejoice** in **the Lord; I will take joy in the God of my salvation**.

- Hebrew *Alaz*, meaning *triumph*, *jump for joy*
- Hebrew Giyl, meaning <u>rejoice</u>, <u>exult</u>, <u>spin around</u>

Zephaniah 3:17 — God's joy over us!

The Lord your God is in your midst a mighty one who will save; *he will* <u>rejoice over you</u> with <u>gladness</u>; he will quiet you by his love; *he will* <u>exult over you</u> with loud singing."

- Hebrew Suws, meaning exult, display joy
- Hebrew Simchah, meaning gladness, glee, pleasure
- · Hebrew Giyl, meaning rejoice, exult, spin around

Nehemiah 8:10

...for the **joy** of the Lord is your strength.

Hebrew Chedvah, meaning gladness, joy

Philippians 4:4

Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, **rejoice**."

• Greek Chairo, to <u>rejoice exceedingly, cheerful, glad</u>

- **ONE** Encountering God's Character in Scripture
 - Jeremiah 9:23-24 The Lord to Jeremiah

Thus says the Lord: "Let not the wise man boast in his wisdom, let not the mighty man boast in his might, let not the rich man boast in his riches, but let him who boasts boast in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am the Lord who practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth. For in these things I delight, declares the Lord."

Psalm 27:4 — David

One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek after: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the Lord and to inquire in his temple."
