### Haiti — feed hundreds of children every single day

- January Distribute Haiti shoe boxes, honor staff and teachers, go door to door with The Timothy Initiative to share the gospel and pray for needs. As well as make an initiative to reach out to the elderly in the town of Milo.
- May Seminar for the elderly about heaven, demonstrated raised garden growing and shared the gospel by going door to door in the communities
- August Seminars for the elderly women, young adult, and school age girls about walking in their identity in Christ
- October Seminars for women and daughters on identity with Christ, and parenting and raising Godly children. Outreach evangelist opportunity, and constructed benches for new church!

### Dominican Republic — Josiah's House / Giovanna's House

- We continue to move forward with the vision of Josiah's House and Giovanna's House: to share the love of Jesus with orphaned and abandoned children, raising them to one day become godly men and women who can impact their nation!
- 2018 was a year of **family restoration** at Josiah's House. During this past year, they worked intentionally to help restore some of the broken family relationships of our Josiah's House kids.
- Carlos turned 18 this year and is the first of the Josiah's House kids to reach this
  milestone. He also reconnected with his biological father whom he has never really
  known. Carlos just moved in with his father and is happy to begin building that special
  relationship!
- The Josiah's House staff continues to grow. In 2018 two new families became part of the Josiah's House staff.

#### Mexico

- June Attended Bible studies of our church plant in Navojoa, Mexico. Minister to those in small villages, and the local prison. Also made improvements to Rancho Maranatha guest house (to better facilitate GC teams in the future)
- November/December Visited Bible study in the small villages and minister to families and individuals of an early stage church plant. Facilitate a Sunday day of celebration, teach and fellowship for the Bible study groups. Sharing in local men's and women's prison on discipleship and identity.

#### Uganda/South Sudan

- March Representing church and country to promote reconciliation between tribes and visited with GC members of YWAM who live in Aura, Uganda
- September Peace and Reconciliation Initiative between tribes. Kids returned to parents, cattle to owners!!!

## India/Nepal

- o November Seminars with Lamuel Victor in local shelters and schooling of impoverished children. Seminars for pastors and ministry leaders in the local area.
- o 12 men from Grace Chapel along with Hope Force, an international disaster relief organization, partnered with a local organization in Kathmandu, Nepal, known as *Apple of God's Eye*.
- Apple of God's Eye began a project called "Free to Fly", which is a project dedicated to
  restoring the lives of children once trapped in deplorable situations, including sex trafficking.
- o In an effort to help these victims back into an independent society and culture, housing as well as eternal hope through Jesus is offered them.
- Since the massive earthquake in April of 2015, this organization has been recovering. We assisted them in November by constructing a new library and additional classroom as well as spending time discipling their leadership—led by Dave Buehring.

### Campus Situation (least flashy, but necessary)

- to build or not to build huge question, loads of research, lots of time, 18-20 million-dollar expense.
- · we are choosing NOT to build
- what we *must* do build turn lane on Southall, and increased parking, BIG congestion helper!

#### **Fairview**

- we are going to plant a church in Fairview. We have about 800 people who come from there, and beyond, we want to reach more.
- we are making plans and preparations now, it's not a quick thing, we have been given every positive assurance that the FMS is going to open to us.
- · we should start Sunday services in August.
- we have an office and outreach building we bought and are remodeling NOW.
- it will be open for Life Groups and various studies and gatherings soon.
- we'll be sending Pastor Ian and Amanda Gilchrist to start working NOW, they are in the process of moving there NOW.
- we'll keep everyone updated with the progress, very exciting!

# Unique Opportunities — for Pastor Steve — and for us

- listen carefully, don't try to fill in blanks that aren't there, or interpret something that isn't being said, ok?
- over the last several years opportunities have increased for me to speak into various political and spiritual situations, with some very interesting people, both here and abroad. It's nothing I have schmoozed or name-dropped my way into it's been nothing less than an open door from God... those opportunities are increasing.
- God has uniquely positioned us to make a kingdom difference, in unique ways, in unique places.
- these opportunities for us are going to require me to spend time on those issues and travel here and abroad a bit more, which means you will see me preaching a bit less on Sunday mornings. I. AM. NOT. LEAVING. I am answering a call and going through an open door to represent Jesus and Grace Chapel in places and spaces that need Him! It is an incredible honor that God has laid before us.
- we must say yes to this. I say yes by praying, studying and going. You say yes by praying, attending, serving and encouraging next generation pastors. TOGETHER we expand the Kingdom here and abroad in new and amazing ways. What say you?

# 25th Birthday in October- a month of special celebration with special guests!

- Grace Chapel will be 25, I will be 55, I'll be in my 30th year of Sr. Pastoring, and....
- I am believing we will be 100% debt free! Barring anything unusual, we may be able to pay off our

debt with regular giving, if not, we may need to do our smallest amount of a sacrificial offering ever, current total debt 2.8m.

- frees up 160k a month, because we double/triple payments.
- what might we do with 160k a month?
- 10 needs/possibilities Abortion, Adoption/Fostering, Addiction, Abduction/Trafficking, Division/Racism, Incarceration, Disability, Sexuality, Poverty, Suicide.

Beloved — meeting those needs is more valuable to Jesus than building bigger buildings!

We could add an additional service if we ever need to without incurring any new debt.
