He is the God Who sees!

Because He sees us – our brokenness, sinfulness and various needs – He has made promises to meet our greatest needs. What a loving Father!

Start – by bragging on Jesus and *some* of the promises He has made to you and me.

1. No Rejection – Acceptance

• John 6:37

Jesus said, "All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me <u>I will by no means cast</u> out."

• No Rejection – Accceptance

- o idea of a broken, begging criminal coming to house of wealthy, powerful, Nobleman for help.
- we come -- no rejection, life-saving acceptance!
- o Jesus embraces us, bandages our wounds, seats us at the banquet table

2. No Darkness - Light of Life

• John 8:12

- Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

- No Darkness Light of Life
 - no wandering in spiritual darkness, ignorance, confusion, in lies like the lost do
 - clarity, conviction, confidence; you know Whose you are, who you are, what you're doing, where you're going... you're not wandering aimlessly

3. Rest – Not Stress

• Matthew 11:28

Jesus said, "Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and <u>I will give you rest</u>."

- Rest Not Stress
 - at ease in heart and mind about your salvation, be able to holy exhale, and to have a time of recovery from days of striving and stress about your unknown spiritual condition.
 - o I'm home accepted just as I am

4. Peace – Not Panic

- John 14:27 Jesus said, "Peace I leave with you, <u>My peace I give to you</u>; not as the world gives do I give to you."
- Peace Not Panic
 - peace that surpasses understanding because you're in right relationship with the God of the universe, Who is for you, loving you, caring for you, strengthening you!
 - peace that isn't dependent upon favorable circumstances *(like worldly peace)*, rooted in the depths of Christ's promises to you.

5. Freedom – Not Captivity

• John 8:31-21, 36

Jesus said, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and <u>the truth</u> <u>shall make you free</u>. Therefore if <u>the Son</u> makes you free, <u>you shall be free indeed</u>."

• Freedom – Not Captivity

- freedom from the power of sin and the penalty of sin meaning sin has no dominion over me!
- o fear, doubt, addiction, strongholds hell itself has no power over me.
- That's what He came to do set us free!

6. Satisfaction – Not Searching (Woman at the Well)

• John 4:13-14

Jesus said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him <u>will never thirst</u>. But the water that <u>I shall give</u> him will become in him a *fountain of water* springing up into <u>everlasting life</u>."

• Satisfaction – Not Searching

- when you drink the living water Jesus offers no more thirst *the search is over!*
- o trying to find satisfaction in stuff and things, lovers and losers, drugs alcohol...

7. Abundant Life – Not Devilish Destruction

• John 10:10

Jesus said, "The thief does not come except to *steal*, and to *kill*, and to *destroy*. I have come that they may <u>have</u> <u>life</u>, and that they may have it <u>more abundantly</u>."

- Abundant Life Not Devilish Destruction (your choice)
 - o abundant life superabundant, advantaged, privileged, favored
 - not destruction why would I choose that after I've experienced what I have?

8. No Abandonment – Eternal Acceptance

• Matthew 28:20

Jesus said, "<u>I am with you always</u>, even to the end of the age."

- No Abandonment Eternal Acceptance
 - o no rejection opens opportunity to promises, no abandonment points me to them continually.
 - He will never leave you or forsake you even in toughest times!

9. He's Preparing a Place

• John 14:1-2

Jesus said, "Don't let your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you."

- He's Preparing a Place
 - \circ $\,$ no more crying, tears, pain, sorrow, sin, death
 - o joy, peace, beauty, harmony, purity, creativity, ability beyond compare
 - \circ we will have the same resurrection body that Jesus has

10. He's Coming Back

• John 14:3

"And if I go and prepare a place for you, <u>I will come again</u> and receive you to Myself; that <u>where I am</u>, there <u>you</u> <u>may be also</u>."

- He's Coming Back
 - o all signs, prophecies, world events, societal ills point that way. Are you ready?

The Ultimate Promise

Jesus said this to Martha at the grave of her brother Lazarus...

• John 11:25-26

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who <u>believes in Me</u>, though <u>he may die</u>, <u>he shall live</u>. And whoever lives and believes in Me <u>shall never die</u>. **Do you believe this?**"

The ultimate promise is that for the follower of Jesus, they will never die!

• John 5:24

"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has <u>passed from death into life</u>."

• 2 Corinthians 5:4

For we who are in this tent groan, being burdened, not because we want to be unclothed, but further clothed, that mortality may be <u>swallowed up by life</u>.

"Someday you will read in the papers that D. L. Moody is dead. Don't you believe a word of it! At that moment I shall be more alive than I am now. I shall have gone up higher, that is all; out of this old clay tenement into a house that is immortal—a body that death cannot touch; that sin cannot taint; a body just like Jesus' glorious body."¹ ~ D.L. Moody

Repent – Judgment Is Promised

All these promises sound amazing – what must I do?

• Acts 17:30-31

Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now <u>commands all men everywhere to repent</u>, because He has appointed a day on which <u>He will judge the world</u> in righteousness by the Man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by <u>raising Him from the dead</u>.

- Repent Judgment Is Promised
- **Psalm 10:13** Why do the wicked renounce God? He has said in his heart, "You will not require an account."
- Mark 1:15

"The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. <u>Repent</u>, and <u>believe</u> in the <u>gospel</u>."

Believe Good News – Forgiveness Is Available

• John 1:12

But as many as <u>received Him</u>, to them He gave the right to become children of God.

- Believe Good News Forgiveness Is Available
- you broke law, earned death for that, Jesus paid price, offers free gift of salvation.

Receive Jesus – Accept Him, He'll Accept You

Biggest decision of your life – Jesus is inviting you now – humble yourself, find courage – come!

- 5. What is the Ultimate Promise for the follower of Jesus? Do you believe this?
