Grace Chapel Franklin

- Total Tithes & Offerings \$10,247,835 (6% increase over 2018)
- Total Debt \$2,714,863
- Total Outreach -28% of tithes & offerings (which includes Fairview)
- Total number of active people at Grace Chapel 6,218 (2,403 families)

Life Groups Stats

- 102 Life Groups, 30 open
- Around 1,000 people in groups
- Upcoming Community Sunday (February 9) where you can get connected in a group (more details released soon, but if you need community mark your calendars!)

GC Kids Ministry

- We have had 922 kids for the Franklin campus since August.
 - 201 for the Fairview campus, same time period.
- We had approximately 159 salvations for the year.
- VBS
 - o 535 kids including:
 - o 204+ visitors
 - o 43 outreach kids bussed in
 - o 207 volunteers

Middle School Ministry

- MSM had over 150 students get connected to small groups on Wednesday nights where they engaged with one another and their leader in discussions about faith, life and how to follow Jesus
- MSM had 27 adult volunteers that committed to faithfully discipling the next generation by serving as small group leaders
- MSM had 30 students that volunteered to use their gifts to serve on Wednesday nights and Sunday mornings on our Tech, Welcome, and Worship Teams.
- MSM took 70 students to Winter Retreat at Camp Highlands in Elijah, GA, where we spent each morning learning to hear God's voice, each afternoon building relationships and community, and each evening in small groups, worship, and prayer
- MSM took 75 students to Summer Camp at BigStuf in Panama City Beach, FL, where we encountered God in worship, teaching, small groups, and had lots of fun!

High School Ministry

- Worship
 - o Our HSM worship ministry has grown to over 40 student musicians and singers.
- Mexico
 - o HSM took 19 students and 6 leaders to Navojoa, Mexico, to serve and love the community
- Dominican Republic
 - HSM took 8 students to the Dominican Republic to serve with Josiah's House and Giovanna's House.
- LUAU
 - Youth Ministry had 300+ students come out for the annual LUAU to get plugged into community
- Summer Beach Trip
 - HSM took 52 high schoolers and 13 leaders to summer camp, to grow in their relationship with Christ
- Pastor David has also created two classes to equip families
 - "Launch: 7 Conversations Every Parent Should Have" is in its 4th year and has equipped over 87 parents
 - This past Fall, David & his wife Katie began a marriage class called "Together: 7 Conversations Every Couple Should Have."

- Friday Nights
 - Meets in the Sanctuary
 - o Attendance can reach 175 on any given night
- A Typical Friday:
 - o At 6:15 Dinner is Served
 - Over 3,250 meals were served in 2019
 - At 7:00 Worship begins. Includes prayer, tithes and offerings, and message (Looks like a Sunday Morning)
 - o At 8:45 "The After Hour" Community based fellowship time. Volleyball, frisbee, games
- Life Groups
 - Currently 11 Peer Led Life Groups are operating
 - 2 more will start in February
- Missions
 - o 4 Missions Trips
 - 2 to Mexico
 - 1 to the DR/Josiah's House
 - 1 to Panama City for Hurricane Relief

- **February:** Hosted the event on our campus
 - Distributing food to our hungry neighbors
- Also participated in various food distributions throughout the year.

Bonnaroo (Missions and Outreach effort)

- Participated in a ministry effort:
 - Saw hundreds of people come to Jesus/many baptized
 - o several were given hope and the gospel message
 - o Many felt the love of Jesus and encountered people who love them
 - o Supplied 10,000 bottles of water for distribution as a ministry tool

Community Involvement

- Brought children in via bus from Franklin's inner-city neighborhoods to VBS
 - Several said yes to Jesus for the first time
 - Baby Girls Club w/Nicole C. Mullin: Pouring into the young girls in our neighborhoods (up to 40 every Wednesday):
 - Instilling the hope of Jesus using Dance, the Arts, Gratefulness, Honor and above all the Word of God
 - Every week we help feed, mentor, and love the next generation
 - Thankful for Nicole Mullin, Karen Brockington, and Lasonya Thompson for allowing us to partner with them
 - Grace Chapel supports via:
 - Transportation, Classrooms, Financial, and Volunteers/mentors
 - Thankful for ALL of our volunteers from the GC congregation
- Franktown: Mentoring the inner-city youth of Franklin through:
 - o The Gospel, Basic Life Skills, Trades, Mentorship, and Hope
 - Grace Chapel supports via:
 - Transportation, Classrooms, Financial, and Volunteers
- Participated in the Franklin and Leipers Fork Christmas parades
- Participated with High School, Life Group, and Young Adult Ministry in Franklin's Pumpkinfest
 - o Interacted with our community through photo booth, giant jenga, connect four, and crafts.

Missions

• **Haiti** – Delivered Christmas gift boxes to 120 school staff and teachers. Taught a men's conference on "Going the Distance with Jesus."

- **Uganda** Attended the YWAM graduation for the first 12 South Sudanese pastors from the Merle and Dinka tribes, who will facilitate the South Sudan Peace & Reconciliation Initiative in cattle camps in Boma and Jonglei states.
- **Ukraine** Taught on discipleship and spiritual formation at a national conference for worship leaders and musicians from across the country, and across all denominational traditions.
- India Taught faculty on becoming master teachers and business students on leadership in a Christian college and Hindu university. Conducted a two-day pastors conference on Spirit Empowered Living. Ministered to women from the untouchable class on freedom from shame.
- **Mexico** Taught a two-day seminar on Spirit Empowered Living, ministered on freedom in a women's prison, and facilitated a women's conference with women who attend Grace Chapel Navojoa.
- Dominican Republic
 - Freezer Meals and Projects at Josiah's House
 - 1st Medical Missions trip saw 375 Patients in 4 different villages
 - Women's Conference at Josiah's House − 35 women from 3 different villages
 - Passed out 100 Christmas backpacks, food to last a week for 60 homes, and served food to over 100 children
