One more thing- Patience keeps your faith from having an expiration date! So long as you wait patiently, and don't demand that God does something on your timeframe, your faith will never expire! Isn't that awesome?

Listen- No matter the trial or tribulation, patience protects your heart and mind from wavering, and it preserves your faith from expiring!
