## Promises Not Panic Day 10 3/27/2020

Welcome to Day 10 Promises Not Panic- unpacking promises and vanquishing panic! Unpacking Ps 91- benefits and blessings, power and victory of dwelling in the secret place of the Most High, God's very Presence. Today- we wrap up the last 3 verses.

**God speaks-** Psa 91:14 "Because he has <u>set his love upon Me</u>, therefore I will <u>deliver him</u>; I will <u>set him on high</u>, because he has <u>known My name</u>.

- a) set his love- fallen in love, bound himself to Me
- b) deliver him- rescue
- c) set on high- above the noise
- d) known my Name- intimately, experientially, relationally known His nature and character.

**Listen**- warm affection and intelligent trust defines the person who has set their love upon God!

Psa 91:15 He shall <u>call upon Me</u>, and I will <u>answer him</u>; I will be with him <u>in trouble</u>; I will deliver him and honor him.

- a) call and answer- 1Jn 5:14-15 Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.
  - b) be with in trouble- anguish, heartache. Presence is difference-maker.
  - c) deliver- strengthened, called out, and equipped for battle.
- d) honor him- weighty, substantial, influential based on what they've been through.

**Listen-** dwelling in the secret place is deliverance and protection from trials and troubles, and it is also strengthening and preservation in trials and troubles. So, we know power of resurrection AND fellowship of suffering. In that process we're conformed into Christ's image and get honored, become weighty and substantial people.

Psa 91:16 With long life I will satisfy him and show him My salvation."

- a) long life- fills out the measure of his days with satisfaction.
- b) he'll live a full and satisfied life- no matter the length of it.

**Friends**- when your earthly time at God's banquet table is up, you push away from it, fully satisfied, ready to enter into the fuller satisfaction that only heaven can bring.

c) Psalm starts with dwelling in God's Presence from earth- it ends with dwelling in God's Presence in heaven.
