Finished Ps 91- setting our love upon God...

Q. Would you describe your love for God as being passionate, insatiable?

A. If not, encourage you to pursue that.

Reason- when that happens, everything right gets intensified and everything wrong gets minimized.

Today- we need right intensified and wrong minimized. Start unpacking Ps 84.

Psa 84:1 How lovely is Your tabernacle, O LORD of hosts!

Q. What makes God's dwelling place so lovely?

A. Him! Who He is.

Psa 89:8 O LORD God of hosts, Who is mighty like You, O LORD? Your faithfulness also surrounds You.

Psa 89:14 Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; Mercy and truth go before Your face.

Fact- Who God is makes His dwelling lovely, beautiful and glorious!

Psa 84:2 My soul longs, yes, even faints for the courts of the LORD; My heart and my flesh cry out for the living God.

App- because God's dwelling place is so lovely- soul longs, faints, heart, flesh cry out for Him! My entire being wants Him! Passionate and Insatiable.

Psa 84:3 Even the sparrow has found a home, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may lay her young—Even Your altars, O LORD of hosts, My King and my God.

App- even a sparrow knows where to dwell. Swallows know where to nest and bring their young.

Listen- both courts and altars are desired! Wants it all from LORD of hosts, King and God! Passionate and Insatiable!

Psa 84:4 Blessed are those who dwell in Your house; They will still be praising You.
