Psa 34:8 Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good; Blessed is the man who trusts in Him!

Oh! there's a passion in him for others to experience what he has, taste, see LORD good.

- 1. My soul boasts, vs.2
- 2. Oh, magnify with me, vs.3
- 3. Exalt his name together, vs.3
- 4. He's got a heart for people! He's not satisfied just getting his own, wants others!

Tasting leads to an experience with God's goodness-

- 1. trying, testing, leads to experience of God's goodness.
- 2. early days of believing, babes in Christ tasting pure milk of the Word, tasting God's grace, 1Pet 2:2-3.
- 3. Peter, followers, crowds, they were tasters of God's goodness...

Trusting God leads to your blessedness-

- 1. trusting, well beyond tasting, leads to deeper level of experience- your blessedness. Your happy, anchored, immovable resolve.
- 2. Job 13:15 though He slay me, yet will I trust Him!
- 3. This from a man who had tasted so much of the goodness of God, he had to go to the deeper level of trusting God.
- 4. Trusting is a happy and anchored resolve that doesn't fluctuate with circumstance. It's the blessed life!

Listen- one of the ways you can tell whether you are a "taster" or a "truster" is based on how you respond to adversity.
