Heaven: What's Going On Up There? Pt. 2 Steve Berger August 16, 2020

Review

Last week we talked about how people in heaven are alive, active and aware; have heavenly bodies; and how we are surrounded by a great cloud of witnesses.

Today

We'll answer one of the most commonly asked questions about heaven - will there be sin there?

Heaven

Revelation 21:4-5

"And God will <u>wipe away every tear</u> from their eyes; there shall be <u>no more death</u>, nor <u>sorrow</u>, nor <u>crying</u>. There shall be <u>no more pain</u>, for the <u>former things have passed away</u>." Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, <u>I make all things</u> <u>new</u>." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are <u>true and faithful</u>."

- Old world, former things are gone forever, all things new never experienced before
- no more death, <u>death is result of what</u>?
 - Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

• Since death is the byproduct of sin... and there will be no more death... we rightly conclude there will be no more sin!

"The freedom of heaven is the freedom from sin; not that the believer just happens to be free from sin, but that he is so constituted or reconstituted that he cannot sin. He doesn't want to sin, and he doesn't want to want to sin." ~ Paul Helm

Question — Why would we so eagerly look forward to this eternal freedom from sin?

- Answer Because we see the havoc sin causes in our lives now. It will be done away with, think about it...
 - no temptation, no lust of flesh, lust of the eyes, pride of life, no sinful thoughts, attitudes or motives, no hatred, rape, war, racism, no guilt or shame for sin committed!
 - **Revelation 21:27** But there shall by <u>no means enter it anything</u> that <u>defiles</u>, or causes an <u>abomination</u> or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.

Interesting — Four times in the last three chapters of the Bible, it is made very clear that sin and sinners have no part in heaven — their portion is the lake of fire, tormented forever.

Heaven - temptation-less, sinless, shameless, guiltless, deathless, FOREVER! That's Heaven!

1-3 Creativity, Music, Worship

...but not quite like we do here...

Revelation 5:9

And they sang a <u>new</u> song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; For You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of <u>every tribe and tongue and people and nation</u>...

- singing but it is a <u>new song</u>, new song means <u>creativity</u>
- <u>creativity</u> with <u>sinless</u> <u>resurrected</u> <u>bodies</u> imagine the music, art, books by Beethoven, Michelangelo, C.S. Lewis etc.

Application — you creative folks haven't even scratched the surface of what you'll be able to produce.

The fullness of joy, laughter, and pleasures forevermore await us in the presence of God!

5 Enjoying God's Animal Kingdom

Isaiah 11:6-9

The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, the leopard shall lie down with the young goat, the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; And a little child shall lead them. The <u>cow</u> and the <u>bear</u> shall graze; Their young ones shall lie down together; And the <u>lion shall eat straw like the ox</u>. The nursing child shall play by the <u>cobra's</u> hole, and the weaned child shall put his hand in the viper's den. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain, for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD as the waters cover the sea.

- Animals there your personal deceased ones? Evangelist Billy Graham said, "God will prepare everything for our perfect happiness in Heaven, and if it takes my dog being there, I believe he'll be there."⁸
- animals in heaven, all the thrill, none of the danger, they're hanging peacefully together with one another and us... remember we return with Jesus on horses.
- Revelation 4:7-10

The first living creature was like a lion, the second living creature like a calf, the third living creature had a face_ like a man, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle. The four living creatures, each having six_ wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord_ God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!" Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever, the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne...

Application — winged creatures, with eyes all over themselves in heaven speaking, giving glory, honor and thanks... elders respond! The animal kingdom in heaven will be epic!

6 Serving

Revelation 7:15

Therefore they are before the throne of God and <u>serve Him</u> day and night in His temple. And He who sits on the throne will dwell among them.

Revelation 22:3

And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and <u>His servants shall serve</u>. Him.

Application — jobs to plan, plans to execute, building, farming, teaching, exploring, creating — who knows?

Whatever it is, it will only and always be enjoyable, no hassles or opposition that comes with serving God on earth – huge sense of privilege, fulfillment.

7 Reigning with Christ

Revelation 5:10

...And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth.

- not just Kings and Priests...
- we shall **reign** with Him
- responsibility, authority given to oversee God's will based on our rewards.

Conclusion

I hope you see a little clearer that heaven isn't merely "an eternal church service or sing-a-long"₉ (John Eldridge), but is in fact our guiltless, shameless, sinless, resurrected bodies filled with creativity, joy, laughter, pleasures forevermore, worshiping God, enjoying the animal kingdom with no threat of harm, serving, ruling and reigning with Christ as kings and priests. The list goes on and on. Let's set our mind on these things, let's understand that our loved ones in heaven now are living, loving, laughing, learning, creating, worshiping, working, reigning etc. And so will we one day!

- 5. Does the idea of serving, with a sense of privilege and fulfillment, excite you?
- 6. After these past two Sundays, what do you most look forward to in Heaven?
