- Symptoms consistent with COVID-19, which include cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, muscle aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell.

Please abide by the following safety precautions when attending home church:



- Practice proper hand washing/disinfecting etiquette before and after using highly touched surfaces.



- Respect others practice of personal contact (e.g do not assume someone wants to shake hands or greet with a hug). Physical contact may be a line that some are not ready to cross.

By your attending Grace Chapel Fairview, you are stating that, to your knowledge, you have not been exposed to COVID-19 in the last two weeks and have not experienced any symptoms (listed above) of COVID-19. You are also stating that your attendance comes with certain inherent risks of contracting COVID-19 virus, and that you will abide by the procedures established by Grace Chapel Fairview to protect attendees and staff and forever release, waive, and discharge Grace Chapel Fairview, it's employees, volunteers, members, and participants from any and all liability, claims and demands whatsoever, directly or indirectly arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained related to COVID-19.
